

## Introduction to Type 13

Double Suspended Fixed H-Rail with Cable Drops


- Aesthetically pleasing installation
- Stable installation
- Great for frequent wash applications
- Flexible in high ceiling heights
- Plastic sliders or RapidSlider are used to fix the duct to the H-Rail





Ducts are hanged with Adjustable Cable Drops. The H-rail, so named because it looks like a H in the cross section, is made out of anodized aluminum, making it an excellent choice for corrosive environments.

## H-RAIL for Type 13

When assembling an H-rail system the pieces of H-rail are joined together by using a metal connector that is fastened to each rail using set screws. The duct will have sliders or a bulb edge to slide into the H-rail at the appropriate locations for both single and double H-rail configurations. The rails are bent to the exact angle that is needed to suit the elbows in your FabricAir duct system.
